

A work session with the members of the Boydton Town Council was held on Thursday, May 7, 2015, at 5:00 P.M., in the Town Hall Council Chambers with Mayor T. C. Coleman III presiding.

Mayor Coleman III began the work session by stating that the purpose was to discuss various issues that had occurred since the last regular meeting that needed to be addressed before the regular council meeting.

The Mayor informed the council that Mrs. Wendy D. Pulliam has officially resigned her position as Deputy Clerk for the town that would be effective May 15, 2015. He stated that she had accepted a full-time position with benefits. He and others wished her well in her new endeavor.

Mayor Coleman III introduced Mr. Randy Jones, of Dewberry, Inc. to give the council an update on the sewage line that is to be placed at the Microsoft site and how it would affect the town. Mr. Jones explained that the existing eight (8) inch line would still be in place and available for use if the expansion took place; however, another twelve (12) inch line would be placed parallel and adjacent to it, and he also gave more pertinent information regarding the line and further details/plans about the upgrade to the Wastewater Treatment upon receiving the grant money that we hope to receive. The Mayor inquired if the council members had any questions for Mr. Jones. All members seemed satisfied with Mr. Jones explanation/presentation and had no further questions. He was thanked by everyone for his update information.

Website options were presented by Mrs. Wendy Pulliam, Deputy Clerk, with choices the town could make to purchase a web host and provider. After a brief discussion, Vice Mayor Gill moved to approve "Stand Still Designs" along with "Bluehost" to be hired to update our website and design. Councilman W. H. Coleman seconded the motion and all members voted in favor.

The budget discussion was tabled to be discussed next Tuesday night at the regular council meeting.

Issues regarding collection of real estate and personal property taxes were discussed with the council giving the Clerk-Treasurer the authority to pursue collections on the owners who definitely owed the town for unpaid taxes.

The council gave Mayor Coleman permission to sign the agreement with Wells Fargo to accept the house on 865 Jefferson Street, Boydton, VA since the town's attorney, Mr. Jimmy Butts, had reviewed and approved the agreement as was requested by the council.

The Mayor noted that the new maintenance/WWTP employee would begin his new position here on Monday, May 11, 2015.
