

A budget work session of the Boydton Town Council was held on Monday, May 23, 2016, at 5:00 P.M., in the Town Hall Council Chambers with Mayor Thomas C. Coleman III presiding.

Mayor Coleman III stated that due to the unforeseen postponement of the May 17th budget meeting, this was the first budget work session. The Mayor called the meeting to order by stating that the purpose of this work session was to discuss each line item for the town's upcoming proposed 2016-2017 fiscal year budget.

Mrs. Bowen, the Clerk-Treasurer, distributed the newly projected 2016-2017 proposed budget to the Mayor and council members for review. The projected expenses and revenues through June 2016, were discussed and it was determined that there would be no rate increases due to the town's current financial status.

After some discussion on several line items by the council, Mrs. Bowen, Clerk-Treasurer, was questioned regarding their validity, whether some items were listed in the correct category, and advised her to review the questionable line items by making any corrections as necessary, in order for the council to understand the proposed budget more clearly. Upon further discussion, it was the consensus of the council and the Mayor to schedule a "called meeting" for Wednesday, May 25th to review once again and hopefully, finalize the proposed 2016-2017 proposed budget. Mrs. Bowen advised that due to time restraints, the council would need to make a motion on Wednesday night to advertise *once* in a local newspaper (as required by the State Code of Virginia) for a public hearing in order to receive public input on the proposed 2016-2017 fiscal year budget.

Since there was no other business, Mayor Coleman III adjourned the meeting at 6:00 P.M.
