

**A special called meeting of the Boydton Town Council was held on Wednesday, May 25, 2016, at 5:00 P.M., in the Town Hall Council Chambers with Mayor Thomas C. Coleman III presiding.**

**Mayor Coleman III called the special meeting to order. The Mayor stated that the purpose of this meeting was to finalize the town's upcoming 2016-2017 proposed fiscal year budget.**

**A revision of the proposed 2016-2017 fiscal year budget was distributed by Mrs. Bowen, the Clerk-Treasurer, for the council's review. After a brief discussion regarding the changes made to various line items, the Mayor and council were satisfied and agreed with the changes as resubmitted. Mrs. Bowen advised that the proposed 2016-2017 budget *only* had to be advertised *once* in a local newspaper as required by the State Code of Virginia, since there were no rate increases.**

**As in all previous years, a listing of employees with salary information was also circulated for council's review of pay increases. A discussion ensued concerning annual raises for the employees; however, it was determined by council that no raises would be given at this time.**

**Mrs. Bowen advised that a motion was needed to advertise for a public hearing regarding the proposed 2016-2017 budget year. Councilman Ronny C. Worley moved to advertise for a public hearing to be held on Tuesday, June 14, 2016, at 7:30 P.M. Vice Mayor T. G. Gill seconded the motion, with all members voting in favor. Mrs. Bowen advised that in accordance with the State Code of Virginia, an additional meeting, after seven days, would be required to *adopt* the 2016-2017 budget as presented.**

**Since there was no other business, Mayor Coleman III adjourned the meeting at 6:30 P.M.**
