

A “Called Meeting” of the Boydton Town Council to adopt the FY2023-2024 budget, in-town and out-of-town sewage rate increases for anyone using over 3,000 gallons of water, and an increase in out-of-town hook-on fees for water/sewer customers was held on Thursday, June 29, 2023, beginning at 5:00 P.M., in the Town Hall Council Chambers Council Chambers with Vice Mayor T. Vice Mayor T. G. Gill called the meeting to order for the adoption of the FY2023-2024 budget, sewer increases, and out-of-town hook-on connection fees for out-of-town residents.

Councilman W. H. Coleman moved to adopt these sewer rate increases of \$0.54 for in-town residents using over 3,000 gallons and out-of-town customers using over 3,000 gallons would increase by \$1.08. New out-of-town hook-on fees would increase from \$1,250.00 to \$1500.00. Councilman Bill Thompson seconded the motion and all remaining members voted in favor.

The second item of business was to adopt the FY2023-2024 budget. Councilman David M. Crowder moved to adopt the FY 2023-2024 budget that will begin on July 1, 2023, and would proceed through June 2024. Councilman W. H. Bill Coleman seconded the motion, with all remaining member voting unanimously.

The floor was opened for public comments by Vice Mayor Gill, with no additional comments or remarks being made.

Also, on the agenda was an application request from Hannah and Thomas Park III for a Conditional Use Permit at 1036 Jefferson Street for a Home Occupation (Hair Salon). Councilman W. H. Coleman moved to advertise for a joint public hearing between the Boydton Planning Commission and the town council to be held on Wednesday, July 12, 2023, at 5:30 P.M. in the Town Hall Council Chambers. Councilman Ronny C. Worley seconded the motion, with all members voting in favor.

With no other questions, discussion, or concerns the called meeting was adjourned at 5:10 P.M.
