The Mayor stated the Boydton Planning Commission and the Boydton Town Council were meeting to hold a joint public hearing in order to receive and review public comments to consider an application made by R. H. Park III and Hannah Park for a Conditional Use Permit to operate a home occupation (Hair Salon) in a Residential R-1, Division 2 located at 1036 Jefferson Street, Boydton, VA. (Ordinance of 12-11-1999) §2-1, Section 38-182) and owned by Christine H. Park Life Estate & R. H. Park III and described as Tax Parcel TBOY 110A((A)) 031. Once the reason was established for this meeting, Mayor Starke turned the meeting over to the Planning Commission for them to converse between themselves regarding this application. After a brief discussion among the planning commission members, the floor was opened for public comments. A few comments were made in favor of this conditional use permit from the guests. Afterwards, the Mayor declared the Public Hearing closed.

The meeting was reconvened into open session. Dr. Dave Eason, Chairman of the Planning Commission, made a recommendation from their committee to the Town Council of their approval for a Conditional Use Permit application made by Mr. Park III and Hannah Park to operate a home occupation (Hair Salon). Councilman Ronny C. Worley moved to approve this application, as well, with Councilman W. H. Coleman, seconding the motion. All members voted in favor.

Everyone congratulated Mrs. Hannah Park in her endeavor to open her new business and wished her well.
